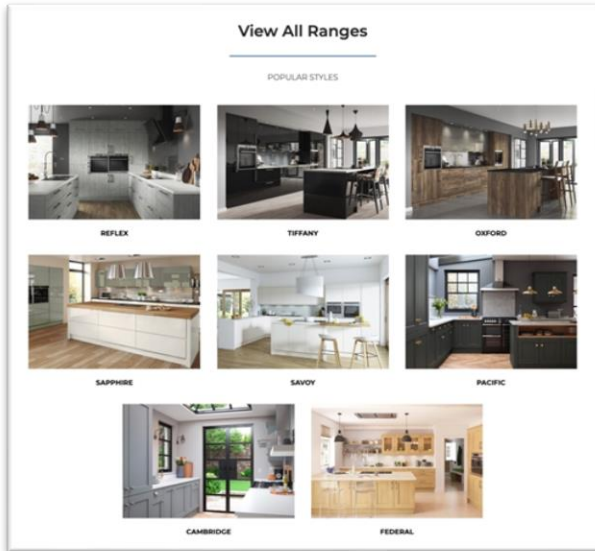


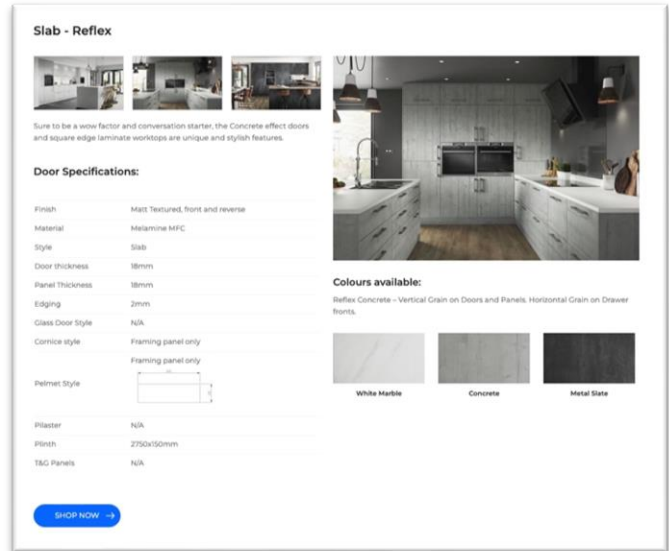
Showcase Module

This guide will show you how to setup the CMS Showcase Module

The showcase is an extra module that you can setup, so you can style your products to present an interactive gallery i.e. (Kitchens, Bedrooms, Bathrooms etc.)

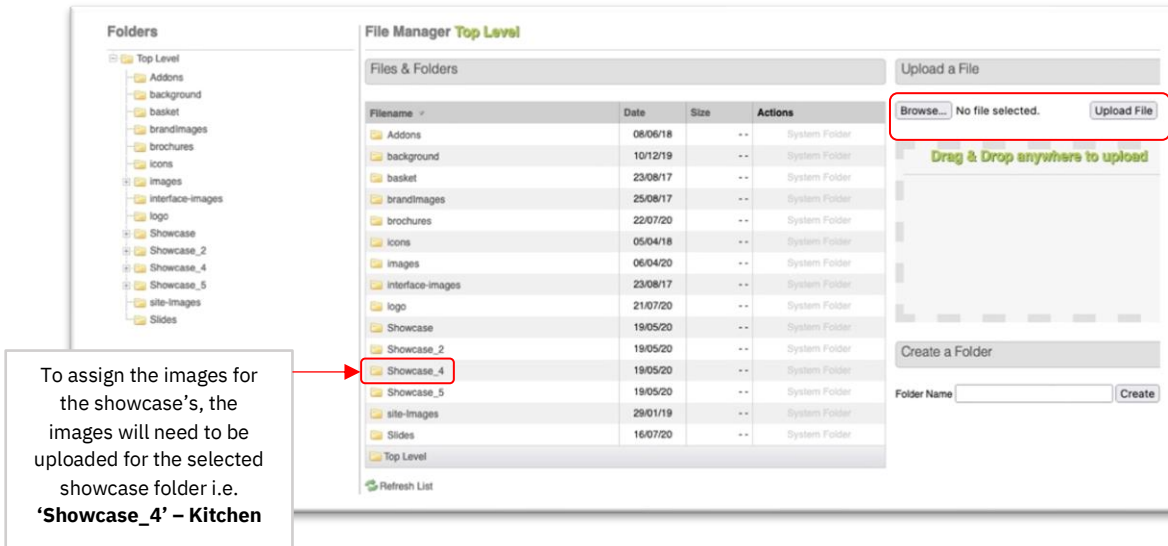
Three separate showcases have been setup in the example above.

If you click on any showcase, you will be able to see the dynamic tag, which can then be used in the **Website > Page** section.

Files:

Go to: **Showcase > Files**

This section is the shortcut link to the file manager, where you can upload your images to the showcase folders.



A file manager or file browser is a computer program that provides a user interface to manage files and folders.

- **Drag and Drop** file uploads happen when you drag one or more files from an underlying platform's file manager and drop them onto a web page for upload. A preview of the image indicates the upload has begun.
- To upload a single file, click **Upload File**, locate, and then select the file you want to upload.
- Files that can be uploaded on the **File Manager**:
 - **JPG / JPEG** is a widely used compressed image format for containing digital images.
 - **PNG** file format is widely used on websites to display high-quality digital images. Created to exceed the performance of GIF files, PNGs offer not just lossless compression, but also a much broader & brighter colour palette.

Showcase Importer:

Go to: **Showcase > Importer**

This is an advanced module & can only be setup by the eStore team, please contact them to find out if the feature is compatible for your website.

Style:

For this section you can add Kitchens Styles i.e. Title, image & content.

Go to: **Showcase > Styles**

- Add a new Style
- Edit this Style
- Delete this Style ✖
- Reorder Style list ⬆️⬆️
- Turn this Style off
 - Light grey text indicates that the Style has been turned **Off**

Actions

Select an image from the drop-down list, which will only display images that have been uploaded to the **Showcase_? > Style** image folder.

Click **'Update'** to save changes

Type:

This is the 1st filter that you can setup to narrow the Kitchens Ranges.

Go to: **Showcase > Types**

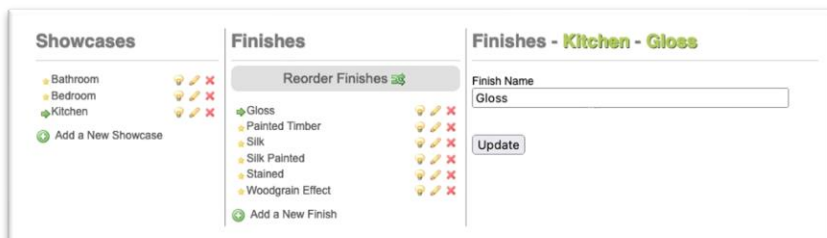

Finishes:

This is the 2nd filter that you can setup to narrow the Kitchens Ranges.

Go to: **Showcase > Finishes**

- Add a new Finish
- Edit this Finish
- Delete this Finish ✖
- Reorder Finish list ⇅
- Turn this Finish off
 - Light grey text indicates that the Finish has been turned **Off**

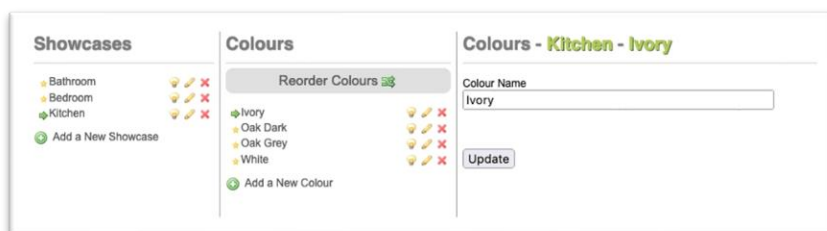


Colours:

This is the 3rd filter that you can setup to narrow the Kitchens Ranges.

Go to: **Showcase > Colours >**

- Add a new Colour
- Edit this Colour
- Delete this Colour ✖
- Reorder Type Colour ⇅
- Turn this Colour off
 - Light grey text indicates that the Colour has been turned **Off**

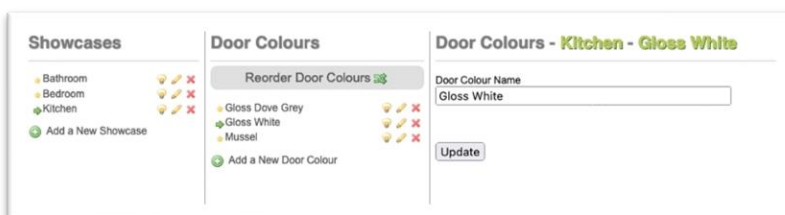


Door Colours:

This is the 4th filter that you can setup to narrow the Kitchens Ranges.

Go to: **Showcase > Door >**

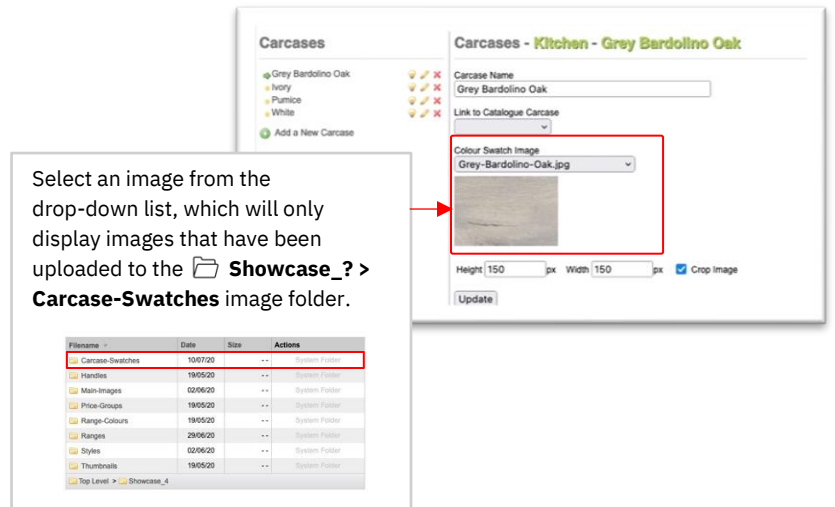
- Add a new Door Colour
- Edit this Door Colour
- Delete this Door Colour ✖
- Reorder Door Colour list ⇅
- Turn this Door Colour off
 - Light grey text indicates that the Door Colour has been turned **Off**



Carcases: In this section you can add Carcase information & assign the images to them.

Go to: **Showcase > Carcases**

- Add a new Carcase
- Edit this Carcase
- Delete this Carcase ✖
- Reorder Type Carcase ⇅
- Turn this Carcase off
 - Light grey text indicates that the Carcase has been turned **Off**



Select an image from the drop-down list, which will only display images that have been uploaded to the **Showcase ? >** **Carcase-Swatches** image folder.

Ranges Groups: In this section you can group kitchen ranges to a collection.

- i.e. This kitchen is part of the Shaker collection (Leave Ranges Groups empty, if not used)

Price Groups: This is the section where you can group items to show in a price band filter (Leave Price Groups empty, if not used)

- **Price Group 1** (£0-£5000)
- **Price Group 2** (£5000-£10000)

Global Settings: In this section you can adjust & overwrite the image dimensions for the showcase layout. This will already be configured by the eStore team members.

Templates: This section is where the eStore designers will build the layout structure of the showcase design i.e. **HTML/CSS**

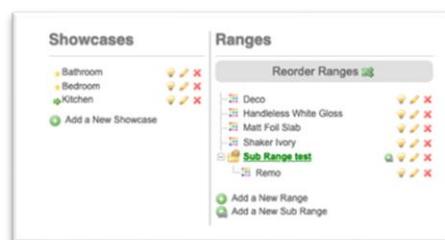
Ranges Section (Build)



Go to: **Showcase > Ranges**

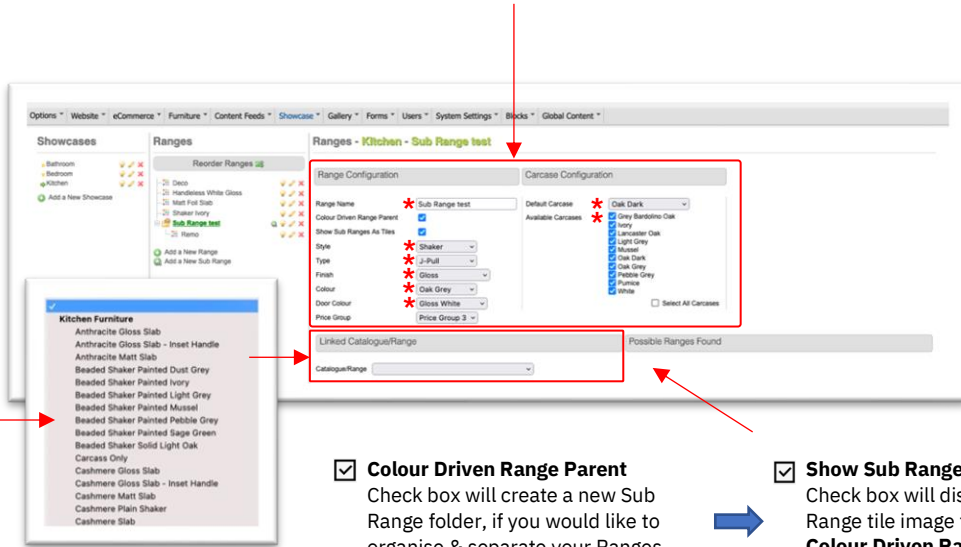
This is the main section where you can build & put everything together. Once Completed it will then display the gallery info on the live site.

- Add a new Range
- Edit this Range
- Delete this Range ✖
- Reorder Range list ⇅
- Turn this Range off
 - Light grey text indicates that the Range has been turned **Off**



From the **Range Configuration** section start to populate and assign the ***Required Fields**

Add a Range Name, Style, Type, Finish, Colour, Door Colours & Carcases info.



This advanced setup is only available for Level 3 Kitchen sites, where you can link showcase Ranges directly to the kitchen store.

Colour Driven Range Parent
Check box will create a new Sub Range folder, if you would like to organise & separate your Ranges.

Show Sub Ranges As Tiles
Check box will display an extra Range tile image to present the **Colour Driven Range Parent**.

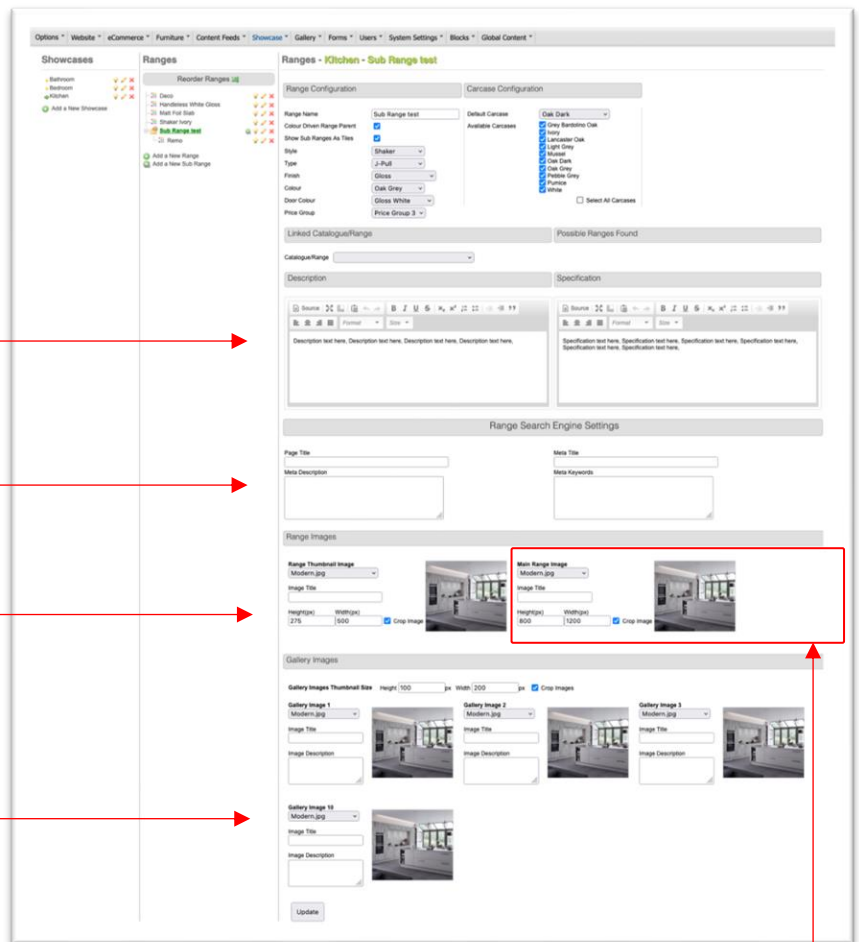
- Add Description text
- Add Specification text

Add Meta Information
Add snippets of text that describe a page's content.

Upload Range image in the **Showcase_? > Ranges** image folder so that they can be selected from the drop-down menu.

Assign Range Gallery images to show i.e. close up shots, colors, details etc.

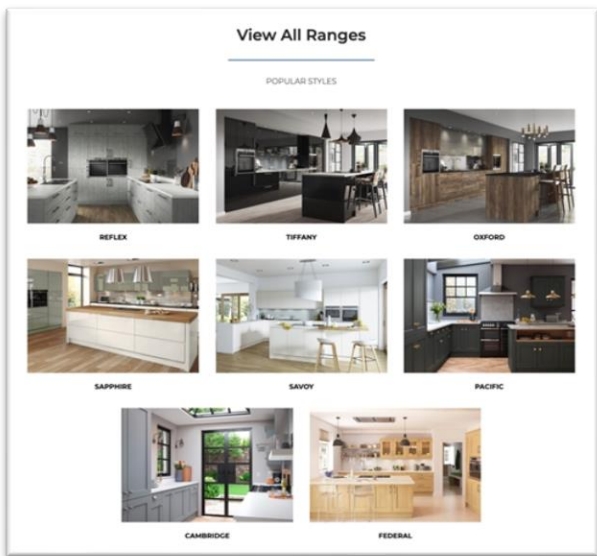
Upload Range Colour image in the **Showcase_? > Range-Colours** image folder so that they can be selected from the drop-down menu.

Once the above have been populated and assigned, you can then switch individual **'Ranges'** on to display them on the live on the website.

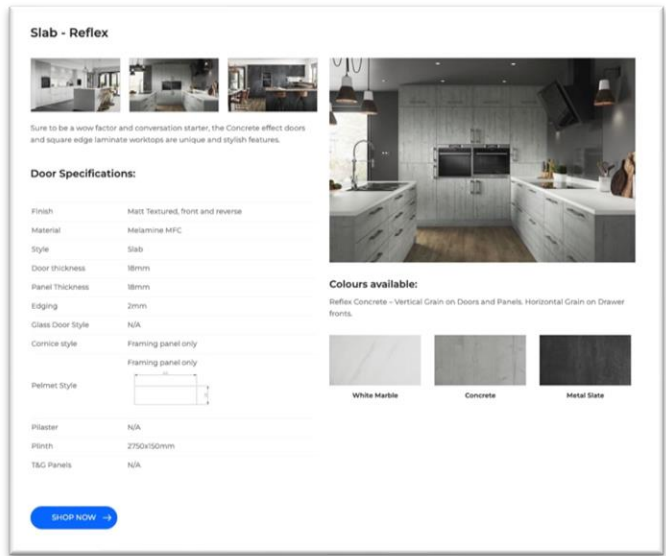
Click **'Update'** to save changes.
